SCHOOL IN ROMANIA

WHAT IS PUBLIC SCHOOL?

Public school is free, the state provides school equipment and lasts eight years:

- Primary school lasts from 7 to 11;
- Secondary school lasts from 11 to 15, they study languages like English or French.

HOW IS SCHOOL THERE?



At the end of secondary school a certificate will be given to students to let them register to secondary high school. It provides three possibilities:

- Vocational school: It lasts two years but after it you can't go to university;
- High school: it lasts four years and it issues diploma of maturity;
- Specific high school: the duration of this school path may vary depending on the address:
- -The Academy (4 years)
- -The Industrial Institute (4 years)
- -The Agricultural and Technical Institutes (4 years)
- -The Artistic Institutes (5 years)

WHAT ARE THE DIFFERENT TYPES OF SCHOOLS?



Graduation allows the enrollment in higher education schools. These are both public and private, and include:

- Universities;
- Academies;
- Polytechnic;
- College.

DESCRIBE A SCHOOL DAY

School starts at 8 a.m. and ends every day at a different time. There is a break every hour and it lasts about 10 minutes. During breaks you can go to the café. In the morning you can eat milk and croissants or just bread. It's interesting that you can go out on your own.

ARE THERE ANY EXAMS?



Classes are held from Monday to Friday for all grades. At the end of primary and secondary school you will perform three tests:

- Romanian language
- Mathematics
- History or geography For the baccalaureate exams will be for:
- Romanian language
- Mathematics
- History or geography
- Foreign languages
- Physical education

WHAT'S THE UNIFORM?

Uniforms are different between males and females:

- Men's uniform: white shirt, tie, blue jacket and trousers.
- Women's uniform: white shirt, blue sleeveless dress, white stockings and a bow.
